Stellar Metamorphosis obeys the natural law of birth, growth, degradation and rebirth or a new law!


What does it mean? The law in its simplest form means that everything in the universe is part of a natural birth and death cycle as known in biology but this death leads to a rebirth, thus creating an endless cycle.

To what 'things' does this law apply to? As stated just before, everything in our universe and maybe the universe itself adheres to this law too, but that would go too far for this paper, so for now it just means that it applies to everything in this universe.

Following below i will state the 4 parts of this law as chapters, explain each part, give examples and provide the form of the law in a picture. I will also proof it applies to Stellar Metamorphosis.

Chapter I – Birth (B)

Chapter II - Growth (G)

Chapter III - Degradation (D)

After the growth period ends; degradation sets in. This can be explained with the second law of thermodynamics; this is wat the second law of thermodynamics states:

"the total entropy of an isolated system can never decrease over time, and is constant if and only if all processes are reversible. Isolated systems spontaneously evolve towards thermodynamic equilibrium, the state with maximum entropy"

Or a simpler way to state it:

"processes that involve the transfer or conversion of heat energy are irreversible"

This means that energy degrades over time (or lose quality) and this process is irreversible. As an example we can see this in humans as they detoriate with age. Humans cells are heat engines, so they are involved in the transfer or conversion of heat energy. Alas, this process is irreversible and over the time conversion degrades the quality of energy. The result is a detoriation of the cells and thus aging ².

Chapter IV – Re-Birth (R)

This entails processes that need to happen before birth is possible again. When you look at nature you can see that the leftovers of systems that have degraded completely and thus died are the fuel of new systems. In the forest leaves fall to the ground and are fuel for other animals but also future trees. Next to this fuel you also need an influx of energy ("new" energy). Systems on Earth get their energy from the Sun and the Sun gets its energy from the galactic center and the galactic center gets it energy from a larger source. And so forth. 
Some notes

The announcement of a new law of nature!



Stellar Metamorphosis obeys this new law


See the Wolynski-Taylor diagram below, i added the new law visually; this stands as proof that Stellar Metamorphosis obeys this new law.

Stars are open systems that adhere to the 2^{nd} law of thermodynamics and thus while losing heat they degrade (as a whole).
